BMCMPO Policy Committee Meeting
December 8, 2023

FY 2024 - 2028 Transportation Improvement Program Amendments and Modifications

- **INDOT: DES#1900098 - SR46 6.04 miles W of SR37 @ Jacks Defeat Creek WBL**
 - Move \$2,390,000 of CN funding from FY 24 to FY 25.

- **INDOT: DES#2000311 - SR46 EB bridge over Jacks Defeat Creek, 4.83 miles W of SR37**
 - Move \$735,960 of CN funding from FY 24 to FY 25 and increase by \$317,115 for a total of \$1,053,075 in FY 25.

- **INDOT: DES#2300013 - VA VARI IDIQ, various locations throughout the Seymour District**
 - Add New Project. This project is in various locations within the Seymour District and has to be shown in all TIPs.

- **INDOT: DES#1800371 - SR37 At intersection of Dillman Road in Bloomington**
 - Move \$1,492,000 of CN funding from FY 24 to FY 25 and increase by \$220,823 of CN funding for a total of \$1,732,823 in FY 25.

- **INDOT: DES#1700198 - SR45 From 0.2 mi E of I-69 (Arlington) to 0.93 mi E of I-69 (Kinser)**
 - Add \$3,430,538 of CN funding in FY 24 for a new total of \$11,289,632.

- **Bloomington Transit: DES# BLO-23-004 Land Acquisition for Service and Fleet Expansion**
 - Increase of \$4,048,558 using STBG funds: \$3,978,983 from a flex transfer and an additional \$69,575 from a Bus Stop Improvements project.

- **Monroe County: DES#1900405 Liberty Drive Connection to Karst Trail**
 - Increase of \$9,000 in CE local; increase of \$456,158.91 in CN local.
