**RESOLUTION FOR ADMINISTRATIVE MODIFICATION/AMENDMENT
TO THE SFY 2024-2028 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP)**

WHEREAS, the Kokomo/Howard County Governmental Coordinating Council (KHCGCC) is the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization, responsible for the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) in the Kokomo and Howard County area, and

WHEREAS, TIP administration, describing the community’s transportation needs of the Metropolitan Planning Area is a requirement of the USDOT, and funds are applied for by the MPO staff of the KHCGCC, and

WHEREAS, the MPO staff of the KHCGCC, INDOT and the LPAs have reviewed the proposed projects, and

WHEREAS, the MPO staff of the KHCGCC, at the request of INDOT to add state project DES 2301312 in the TIP for PE FY 2024, and CN FY 2025. PE FY 24 Federal \$117,000 and State Match \$13,000; CN FY 25 Federal \$547,405 and State Match \$60,823.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by staff of the KHCGCC that the TIP for SFY 2024-2028 be administratively modified as follows:
