<u>David Andrews, P.A., 10001641A – Renewal Application</u>

David Andrews, P.A. appeared before the Committee on his application for renewal of his physician assistant license. Andrews answered "yes" to the question:

1.) Since you last renewed, has any health profession license, certificate, registration, or permit you hold or have held been subject to discipline or are formal charges pending?

Andrews failed to answer "yes" to the question:

2.) Since you last renewed, have you been denied a license, certificate, registration or permit in any state (including Indiana) or surrendered your license?

Andrews' previous application for renewal was denied after he failed to appear before the Committee to answer questions related to his application. Andrews was also the subject of a malpractice lawsuit in Wisconsin. He removed a ganglian cyst, which he believed was a subcanteous cyst. This was outside his scope of practice as permitted by Wisconsin law. He indicated he now has a job opportunity in Indiana and needs his Indiana license renewed. His Wisconsin license is currently unrestricted.

After discussion, the Committee voted to renew his license on INDEFINITE PROBATION for a minimum of two (2) years with terms and conditions, including an annual personal appearance and employer reports.
