Personal Appearances

John Patrick Kenny, IV, MD, Initial application – Positive response:

Dr. Kenny appeared telephonically and was represented by counsel, K. Michael Gaerte, regarding positive response on initial application.

Dr. Kenny is an anesthesiologist, asking for a probationary license.

Dr. Kenny is licensed in IL, began diverting drugs in 2018, has a history of substance abuse. Employer confronted him, signed a contract with IL physician assistant program immediately. Was not referred for criminal prosecution, no charges filed.

Dr. Kenny was released for cause from job and surrendered credentials. He checked into Bradford Health in AL for a 3-month inpatient treatment for opioid use disorder in April 2018.

Dr. Kenny issued license on probation, and he has provided the Board with his IL consent order. Once he applied in IN he hie contacted ISMA and singed a contract with them.

Dr. Kenny has an MOA with the DEA – will need an IN CSR once released from MOA.

The requested evaluation was submitted for the Board's review. Hospital has a history of retaliatory termination, provided letters from past co-workers and prospective In employer.

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Bernard Rerri, MD, License 01078105A - Renewal – Positive response – Previously tabled:

Dr. Rerri appeared telephonically and was not represented by counsel regarding a positive response on a renewal application.

Dr. Rerri previously appeared before the Board at their 12.2.2021 meeting, the Board tabled application until he could provide: hospital procedure logs, letters of reference from hospital and co-workers, and a brief description of current medical malpractice cases.

Dr. Rerri submitted for the Board's review: hospital logs, letters from Gaye Shaw, Manager, Medical Staff Affairs SSM Health St. Mary's Hospital – Centralia, employment letter from Kimberly Edwards, The Medical Hospitals, Dr. Komanduri, Orthopedic surgeon, and Richard Oni, Orthopedic and spine surgeon.

Dr. Rerri stated he had a tax issue in IL, his medical license in IL was suspended in 2019 until he made payment, then license was reinstated.

Dr. Rerri is an orthopedic spine surgeon. Stated he has had 12-13 medical malpractice cases in the last 10 years. One settled, 9-10 still active. Board questioned Dr. Rerri regarding these cases, had 2 large settlements over \$1 million dollars. Currently has "about 6" pending medical malpractice cases, states he has had none filed since 2017.

Dr. Rerri states he had an unfortunate period in my career when I was doing 30-35 fusion surgeries per month and had a 1-2% complaint rate.

One has been open since 2016, she has been cleared from the case after radiologist review but is still attached to case. Second case stems from an ultrasound done in 2014, failure to diagnose torsion, case settled.

Dr. Alzoobi discussed a reprimand he received from IL for a case that happened two years ago. It is ongoing, patient care is under review for failing to recognize addiction possibility.

Dr. Knoble did not appear at scheduled appearance before the Board.

Alton Parker, MD, License 01065486A - Renewal – Positive response:

Dr. Parker appeared telephonically and was represented by counsel, Elliott Pinkie, regarding a positive response on a renewal application.

Dr. Parker addressed positive response on his renewal, was briefly excluded from Medicare in 2020 was doing telehealth worked for them for about 10 weeks, CMS asked for records and company was not reputable and had stopped paying medical records company.

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Dr. Parker also has an alcohol use disorder, relapsed in December 2019. Was dismissed from ISMA in January 2020. Made arrangements on his own to enter Pine Grove inpatient care in MS. This was previously investigated by the OAG and no complaint was filed. Has continued compliance with Affinity e-health. Dr. Parker did not relapse on job, and it did not interfere with patient care. His sobriety date is 12.19.2019.

Anne Kelly, PAP coordinator, ISMA (PAP) – stated that if the Board recommended re-entry into the ISMA program they would take that into consideration and would re-evaluate Dr. Parker.

Dr. Parker is currently working as a hospitalist doing telehealth in Henry County. States that if the Board recommended re-entry into the ISMA program he would be willing to sign contract with them.

After discussion, the Board moved to TABLE Dr. Parker's renewal application to give him time to get safeguards in place such as re-enrolling in ISMA.

Dr. Jacobs discussed a medical malpractice case. Was conducting interoperative neuromonitoring, was a bad case, tried to get surgeon to stop, patient ended up paralyzed, unfortunate result, large settlement.

Dr. Harris is Board certified in neurology, specializing in late-stage prostate cancer. CEO of practice in the Chicago area. Has been about 30 years since his last medical malpractice case.

Dr. Harris discussed reprimand in IL that stemmed from incident that began in 2013. Over a two-year period of time Dr. Harris wrote 2-3 prescriptions for Ambien for a nurse practitioner. He charted it, did it out in the open. Colleague's husband filed a complaint. Reprimanded in IL for "friendly prescribing". Received letter of reprimand, \$2k fine and completed required CE.

I was a solo practitioner, no opportunity for supervision so privileges were not expanded until I got stateside to a larger area. Under military rules I could not do anything until supervision was available, it is not a disciplinary process it is a quality issue. I did not practice from Aug 2020 – Aug 2021, was doing administrative work. Now practicing again with supervision.

Dr. Jain states that he joined the VA hospital in Indianapolis in 2014, saw many problems, filed whistleblower complaints. I reported machinery that was stolen from the VA. New chief of cardiology came in in late 2018, many cardiologists left. I had privileges in good standing 2017 – 2020 then after I resigned, they said my privileges had been suspended. Eventually VA said it was a typographical error.

Board stated they saw ling investigation by OAG into facility he worked at, Dr. Jain stated he cooperated with them and gave them names.

Dr. Walker stated that he has not seen a patient since November 2019 incident in the ER. Hospital executive committee put me on probation and were going to suspend my privileges, I decided to retire instead. I was notified that after the executive committee decision I was reported to the NPDB.
