CALL TO ORDER & ESTABLISHMENT OF QUORUM

EDUCATION

Personal Appearance of Brenda Dant

RE: Curriculum of Mechanical Skills, Inc. Plumbing Apprentice Program

Ms. Dant appeared before the commission at the last meeting to seek approval of new course curriculum at Mechanical Skills. John Delgado from Office of Apprenticeship Training also addressed the board stating

the national standard of PHCC has been accepted. One point stressed is students living with a certain radius of the school should be receiving hands on training at the school in the area.

Commission Action: Matt Buczolich moved to approve the amended online curriculum. Eric Ott seconded the motion. Motion carried with a vote of 4/0/1 William Circlio abstained; wanted it on the record he is affiliated with Mechanical Skills and has been for 30 years.

Personal Appearance of Evansville Local 136

RE: Failure to require students to obtain a plumber apprentice license during internship.

Mike Faulkenstein appeared before Commission to discuss his time as the training coordinator with Local 136 when 2 out of 3 apprentices were in the apprentice program are listed as pipefitters on the BAT agreement. A suggestion was made to have the individuals to go back to Apprenticeship Training to see if they would be able to get credit for the apprenticeship training. John Delgado interjected and stated they would have to be registered in the apprenticeship program for at least 1000 hours. Board Director Christina (Tina) Wiseley will compile a letter to send to Local 136.

Mr. Trinkle returned before the commission with court documents stating the charges pending. William Ciriello made motion to allow Eric Trinkle's license to be renewed. Robert Synko seconded motion. Motion carried with a vote of 5/0/0

A. In the Matter of the Unlicensed Practice of Gary Bright Cause Number IPC 11-14

Case Summary: Respondent did not appear.

Commission Action: William Ciriello made motion to find Gary Bright in default. Matt Buczolich seconded motion. Motion carried with a vote of 5/0/0

Case Summary: Once the commission found Gary Bright in default, Joseph Basile represented the State. Sharon Elfenbaum was a witness for the state and she is a case analyst for the OAG. Ms. Elfenbaum indicated that she found advertisement for "Bright's" plumbing without a PC license. The advertisement offers plumbing services and has listed license number, 31527890, which is not a valid license number. An additional advertisement was found in the phone book indicates a license number 27011382, which is

not a valid license number. Mr. Bright indicated to Sharon Elfenbaum that they made the number up, but couldn't remember why it was made up, and that they don't have a license.

Case Summary: State present case on how Anytime Plumbing Repair is offering services without being licensed. Sharon Elfenbaum, state witness, indicated she found advertisement offering plumbing services and shows not license number. An online advertisement was presented as well. State closed case with summary and requested the commission to issue a cease and desit order.
