



Potential Glass End Users in Indiana




2019 Reported Glass Flow of Materials to Out of State Facilities


Potential Metal End Users in Indiana




2019 Reported Metal Flow of Materials to Out of State Facilities




2019 Reported Fiber Flow of Materials to Out of State Facilities




Potential Plastic End Users in Indiana




2019 Reported Plastic Flow of Materials to Out of State Facilities
