#### REPORT OF FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

# **Commission on Improving the Status of Children in Indiana**

## I. DIRECTIVES

In accordance with Legislative Council Resolution 13-01, the Commission on Improving the Status of Children in Indiana was charged with studying the following topics:

- A. The study topics assigned to the commission by SEA 125-2013, SECTION 1 (vulnerable youth).
- B. The study topics assigned to the Committee on Child Care (IC 12-17.2-3.3-2) by SEA 305-2013, SECTION 18 (due process for child care providers).
- C. The following:
  - i. Whether Indiana should require a photograph of a SNAP recipient on the recipient's electronic benefits transfer (EBT) card.
  - ii. Whether Indiana should require a SNAP recipient to show the recipient's photo identification issued by a federal, state, or local unit when the recipient uses the recipient's electronic benefits transfer (EBT) card.
  - iii. Whether Indiana should seek approval to allow the distribution of SNAP benefits to a recipient on a bimonthly basis.

(SEA 530-2013, SECTION 2).

#### II. SUMMARY OF WORK

The Commission met two times during the 2013 interim session, on August 21, 2013 and October 16, 2013 at the Indiana Government South Conference Center.

#### **III. COMMISSION FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS**

No findings of fact were made by the Commission.

The commission makes the following recommendations:

(1) SEA 305-2013, SECTION 18 (due process for child care providers).

#### The Commission recommends the issue be tabled.

(2) SEA 530-2013, SECTION 2-addressing problems of SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program), as follows:

i. Whether Indiana should require a photograph of a SNAP recipient on the EBT (Electronic Benefit Transfer) card.

#### The Commission recommends no action be taken on this item.

ii. Whether Indiana should require a SNAP recipient to show a photo identification issued by a federal, state or local unit when the EBT card is used electronically.

#### The Commission recommends no action be taken on this item.

iii. Whether Indiana should seek approval to allow the distribution of SNAP benefits on a bimonthly basis.
