The Council of State Governments (CSG) Justice Center has offered their support to improve Indiana's juvenile justice system by collaborating with the Commission on Improving the Status of Children. This partnership would entail a financial commitment from the State of \$50,000 so that CSG can conduct a preliminary assessment of Indiana's juvenile justice system, particularly focusing on data collection. As the Chair of the Commission on Improving the Status of Children, your support is paramount to the success of this endeavor, which will inform future system-wide reforms to ensure that Indiana is best serving our youth.
