Summary of Recommendation:

The Educational Outcomes Task Force asks the Commission to endorse the Indiana Commission for Higher Education's 2022 recommendation to automatically confirm eligible students' low-income status for initial enrollment in the 21st Century Scholars program as 7th and 8th graders. Streamlining application procedures will assist low-income families and free up resources to promote the program and support students in completing mandatory activities, such as the Scholar Success Program.

Background of Recommendation:

What is the need or problem, and how does it impact disparate populations?

Data shows that participation in the 21st Century Scholars program improves low-income students' access and completion of postsecondary education. Scholars matriculate at higher rates than all Indiana students, regardless of income. They are also more likely to persist and complete postsecondary than their low-income peers. By removing barriers to enrollment in 7th and 8th grade, more low-income students will receive support while in high school and be able to earn a scholarship for education after high school.
