## **Summary of Recommendation:**

- 1. Create a guide to understanding how to select evidence-based services for youth in and exiting the Department of Corrections and their families and make it available and accessible on the in.gov website.
- 2. Create a brief, mandatory survey for all licensed mental health and behavioral health professionals that must be completed during the license renewal process that gathers data pertaining to:
  - a. Whether they are actively practicing in their field
  - b. Their geographic area of service
  - c. The demographics of the populations they serve
  - d. Whether they use telemedicine to provide their services
  - e. Any other relevant data useful in determining service accessibility or gaps

## **Background of Recommendation:**

What is the need or problem?

- 1. Department of Corrections (DOC) staff have requested a guide and listing of resources to help them select evidence-based programs for the youth and families that they serve. Marc Kniola, Youth Services Program Director at the DOC, created a one-page guide that explains how to select an appropriate evidence-based program and lists several national on-line resources that provide lists of such programs.
- 2. Currently, the state of Indiana does not have accurate or complete information on mental health service providers that would help identify the areas of the state experiencing significant gaps in access. A mandatory
