

Iroquois Game Bird Area

Jasper County, Indiana



Iroquois Game Bird Area is a 160-acre property. It was purchased by the Division of Fish & Wildlife in 2015 using a combination of funding sources, with land bank being the most significant. The property is broken up into a variety of habitat types including pastureland, prairie, annual weeds, and three tree/shrub plantings.

Access is by written permit only and is awarded only for hunting opportunities, research, and volunteer conservation work. No other access is granted. Call Willow Slough FWA at 219-285-2704 for more information.

Directions: From Rensselaer, travel north on S.R. 231 to 300 S. Turn east onto 300 S. and travel approximately 2 miles to county road 330 W. Turn north. 330 W. will snake around and turn into 300 W. Iroquois will be on the west side of the road. Park in the area designated on the map.
