

BITTERN BOG WETLAND CONSERVATION AREA



Bittern Bog Wetland Conservation Area
(Managed By Kankakee Fish & Wildlife Area)

Description: Bittern Bog WCA is approximately 74 acres. Over half of the property is enrolled in the WRP Program and contains several shallow water areas. The remainder of the property is composed of warm season grasses and sedge meadow habitat.

Location: Bittern Bog WCA is located on County Road 400 North between County Roads 800 East and 900 East in Starke County.

Parking: Parking is located in a designated lot on County Road 400 North. All other property lanes or roads are closed to vehicles.

Hunting Regulations: Waterfowl Hunting – by draw, only on Wednesdays and Sundays. Drawing held at Kankakee FWA. All other hunting allowed after Noon during waterfowl season.

Deer Hunting – Archery only.

No night hunting or dog running

Steel shot only.

No hunting within the safety zone around the house located at the property.

All other hunting allowed within State and Federal Regulations.

Other Permitted Uses: Wildlife viewing, hiking, and mushroom hunting are also allowed on the property. No sign-in required.

Restricted Uses: No open fires. No camping. No swimming. No horseback riding. No ATV's or snowmobiles.

No trapping without written permission from the Kankakee FWA Property Manager.
