

DICK BLYTHE WETLAND CONSERVATION AREA



**Dick Blythe Wetland Conservation Area
(Managed by Kankakee Fish & Wildlife Area)**

Description: Dick Blythe WCA is approximately 202 acres. The property includes 20 seasonally flooded impoundments with the remainder being warm season grasses and sedge meadow habitat. The Kankakee River borders the property on one side.

Location: Dick Blythe WCA is located just north of U.S. 30 on County Road 50 East in LaPorte County.

Parking: Parking is located in a designated lot off of County Road 50 East. All other property lanes or roads are closed to vehicles.

Hunting Regulations: Waterfowl Hunting – by draw, only on Mondays and Fridays. Drawing held at Kankakee FWA. All other hunting allowed after noon during waterfowl season.

Deer Hunting – Archery only

Quail and Pheasant Hunting – allocated through drawing held at Kankakee FWA.

No night hunting or dog running.

Steel shot only.

All other hunting allowed within State and Federal regulations.

Fishing Regulations: Fishing is allowed in the Kankakee River. All fishing is subject to State regulations. No check-in is required for fishing.

Other Permitted Uses: Hiking, mushroom hunting, and wildlife viewing are also allowed. No check-in is required.

Restricted Uses: No open fires. No camping. No Swimming. No horseback riding. No ATV's or snowmobiles.

No trapping without written permission from the Kankakee FWA Property Manager.
