

## Cattail Slough Game Bird Area Newton County, Indiana



Cattail Slough Game Bird Area is an 80-acre parcel that was purchased in 2009. This acquisition was funded through North American Wetlands Conservation Act grant. The property lies low and has many shallow wetlands scattered around. The property is also enrolled in the Wetland Reserve Program administered through the Natural Resources Conservation Service. It is split by a large ditch which is sometimes not crossable. To access the east half of the property, park in the east lot. An easement for access to the property is along the fence row, though it cannot be hunted. Hunting can begin once you enter the main property.

Access is by written permit only and is awarded only for hunting opportunities, research, and volunteer conservation work. No other access is granted. Call Willow Slough FWA at 219-285-2704 for more information.

Directions: Travel S.R. 41 to S.R. 16. Head west on C.R. 900 S. Go approximately 3 miles and turn right (north) onto 600 W. Go ½ mile north on 600 W. and the main parking area will be on the right (east).

GPS coordinates for the main lot area: (40.873286, -87.50546). The secondary lot area: (40.873416, -87.491684). All boundaries on the map are approximate.
