FI	INDINGS AND FINAL DETERMINATION ON PRO JULY 20, 2012	OPOSED QUESTION SUBMITTED	
1.	Mt. Vernon Community School Corporation ("Corporation") proposes to place an operating referendum on the ballot for the purpose of establishing a referendum tax levy with a tax rate not to exceed eighty-five hundredths cents (\$0.085) per one hundred dollars (\$100) of assessed value.		
2.	Under Indiana law, voters in the area served by the Corporation will vote in a referendum to approve or deny the Corporation's proposed tax rate.		
3.	Indiana law governs the format and wording of the ballot question for the referendum.		
4.	Under Indiana law, the "question to be submitted to the as follows":	Indiana law, the "question to be submitted to the voters in the referendum must read lows":

	Indiana Code 20-46-1-10 (emphasis added).		

- 5. The ballot question then must contain two parts:
  - the number of calendar years for which the tax will be in effect; and
  - the amount of the tax rate.
- 6. The law requires the Department of Local Government Finance ("Department") to review the language for compliance with IC 20-46-1-10. The Department may either approve or reject the language.

- 7. On July 20, 2012, the Department received a letter from the Corporation presenting the proposed ballot question for the referendum.
- 8. The Corporation requested that the Department review this proposed question:

"For the three calendar years immediately following the holding of the referendum, shall Mt. Vernon Community School Corporation impose a property tax rate that does not exceed \$0.085 on each one hundred dollars (\$100) of assessed valuation and that is in addition to all other property tax levies imposed by the school corporation?"

## Compliance of Language

9. The Department must review the proposed language for compliance with IC 20-46-1-10. The Department may either approve or reject the language. The Department concludes that the language is in compliance with IC 20-46-1-10.

## **Final Determination**

WHEREFORE, based on the above findings and applicable law, the Department finds that the proposed language is in compliance with IC 20-46-1-10 and approves the language as proposed.
