This grant was created by the Indiana Native American Indian Affairs Commission for the purpose of providing teachers and their students an opportunities to enrich the learning experience for their students with a focus on Indiana Native American history, heritage, and contemporary culture.

Eligibility requirements:

- Field trips must be to a location within the State of Indiana
- The excursion must have a connection to the approved Indiana education curriculum
- Applicants must complete and return the accompanying Field Trip Grant After-Action Report within 30 days of the excursion

Priority will be given to schools that have not received this grant within the last year.

DEADLINE: Must submit to the INAIAC Office 60 days prior to the trip.
