#### **MINUTES**

#### ALCOHOL AND TOBACCO COMMISSION

### JANUARY 17, 2017

## CALL TO ORDER/NOTING OF QUORUM

Chairman Cook called the meeting to order and noted the quorum and the attendance. Present were Commissioner Maginn and Commissioner Grubb. Prosecutor Mader, Commission Counsel Allen, Executive Secretary Rothenberg, Corporal Lynch and Superintendent Strittmatter, were also in attendance.

Brooke Burtnett, Jane Gentry, Teri Quimby, Mark Webb, George Douglas, Pat Flynn, Jr., Schuyler Culver, Matt Brase, Sarah Stegmeyer, Stan Ziherl and Davey Neal were present as observers.

## DISPOSITION OF MINUTES

Commissioner Maginn moved to approve the minutes from the January 4, 2017 meeting. Commissioner Grubb seconded. The motion was unanimously approved.

#### PROSECUTOR'S RECOMMENDATIONS

<u>PARTIES' AGREED DISPOSITIONS</u> – Prosecutor Mader recommended the Commission approve the 67 Parties' Agreed Dispositions that were submitted, totaling \$23,575.00 in fines.

Commissioner Grubb moved to approve the Dispositions that were submitted for the January 17, 2017 meeting. Commissioner Maginn seconded. The motion was unanimously approved.

### HEARING JUDGE'S RECOMMENDATIONS

RR32-01070 R & M INDUSTRIAL SUPPLY, INC. – Executive Secretary Rothenberg noted this was an appeal on a denial of a renewal. The denial was based on the permittee having four violations over an eight year period. The permittee's attorney provided information that numerous permits were approved for renewal with the same or more violations, even in the same county as this permittee. The Hearing Judge recommended the renewal be approved for one year under strict compliance.

Commissioner Maginn moved to uphold the Hearing Judge's recommendation to renew the permit for one year under strict compliance. Commissioner Grubb seconded. The motion was unanimously approved.

## CONSIDERATION OF APPLICATIONS

Commissioner Grubb moved to approve and incorporate by reference these lists of permits for renewal, which have been recommended by local boards and reviewed by our staff with the authority of the commission and hereby move for approval of same and the inclusion of these lists as part of the minutes. Commissioner Maginn seconded. The motion was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Grubb moved to approve and incorporate by reference these lists of permit applications for a new permit, or applications for changes in location or ownership or both of existing permits, which have been recommended by local boards and reviewed by at least two commissioners and hereby move for approval of same, pending final floor plan approval by the Indiana State Excise Police, and inclusion of these lists as part of the minutes. Commissioner Maginn seconded. The motion was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Grubb moved to approve and incorporate by reference these lists of applications for catering. Commissioner Maginn seconded. The motion was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Grubb moved to approve and incorporate by reference these lists of permits to be placed in escrow for not more than five years, which have been reviewed and recommended by a commissioner as appropriate for escrow and hereby move for approval of same and the inclusion of these lists as part of the minutes. Commissioner Maginn seconded. The motion was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Grubb moved to approve one permit for sixth year escrow. It is currently pending before the court of appeals. Commissioner Maginn seconded. The motion was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Grubb moved to approve the renewal carrier permits. Commissioner Maginn seconded. The motion was unanimously approved.

Seven hundred fifteen (715) renewals approved, seventy-one (71) new and/or transfer applications approved, eight (8) permits approved for catering, sixteen (16) permits approved for first year escrow, eighteen (18) permits approved for second year escrow, five (5) permits approved for third year escrow, one (1) permit approved for fourth year escrow, one (1) permit approved for sixth year escrow, twelve (12) new and renewal carrier permits approved and four (4) new direct wine shipper permits approved.

### RENEWAL LETTERS AND WAIVER OF FEES

Commissioner Maginn moved to approve the renewal and fee waived letters of extension for the preceding weeks. Commissioner Grubb seconded. The motion was unanimously approved.

## APPLICATIONS FOR DISCUSSION

RR71-18326 THE BREW PUB, LTD. – Executive Secretary Rothenberg stated this permittee is requesting the type 209 permit be converted to a type 210 permit. When this permit was originally issued, the location was outside of the city limits. Over the years, unbeknownst to the owners, the location was annexed, but was continued to be renewed as a permit outside the city limits. The permittee is getting ready to file a transfer, so they were made aware of the annexation. The conversion will make the city over quota by one.

Commissioner Maginn moved to approve the conversion. Commissioner Grubb seconded. The motion was unanimously approved.

<u>RR33-30103 ADHOYEE, LLC</u> – Chairman Cook noted this is a renewal with the local board voting 3-0 to deny. The permittee did not appear at the local board meeting as required, due to violations.

Commissioner Grubb moved to uphold the local board's recommendation to deny the renewal. Commissioner Maginn seconded. The motion was unanimously approved.

<u>DL16-98202 RATTAN ENTERPRISES, INC.</u> – Chairman Cook noted this is a renewal with the local board voting 3-0 to deny. The permittee did not appear at the local board meeting as required, due to violations.

Commissioner Grubb moved to uphold the local board's recommendation to deny the renewal. Commissioner Maginn seconded. The motion was unanimously approved.

<u>RR12-00982 MICK AND DEBS ANIMAL HOUSE</u> – Chairman Cook noted this is a renewal with the local board voting 3-0 to deny.

Commissioner Maginn stated the owner is a non-managing owner. There have been numerous issues involving over-serving patrons, fights and serving past serving hours at the establishment. The owner has made no effort to address any of these matters.

Commissioner Maginn moved to uphold the local board's recommendation to deny the renewal. Commissioner Grubb seconded. The motion was unanimously approved.
