HUMAN TRAFFICKING: IT HAPPENS HERE

Human Trafficking is tied as the **SECOND LARGEST** and **FASTEST** growing criminal industry in the world, producing \$150 billion per year.

... And it's HAPPENING IN INDIANA

There are two types of human trafficking:

- 1) Sex Trafficking: when a person used in commercial sex is under the age of 18; or, a person is used in commercial sex through the use of force, fraud, or coercion.
- 2) Labor Trafficking: when a person is recruited to work or provide services through the use of force, fraud, or coercion.

Human Trafficking Red Flags:

- Victim accompanied by someone who appears very controlling
- Signs of physical abuse and/or psychological trauma
- Victim may believe they have to work for the employer because of a debt they owe
- Conversations are scripted, inconsistent and/or vague
- Signs of "branding" such as tattoos or jewelry
- Worker who doesn't carry his/her own ID
- Constantly short of cash
- Physical abuse
- Older man/woman picking up the worker after work
- Possible fake ID/doesn't look as old as he/she says
- Brought in to work by older man/woman
- Seems to be making "dates" while at work

Know the facts:

- 12-14 years old is the average age U.S. children are first used in commercial sex.
- Nearly 300,000 U.S. children are in danger of becoming sexual commodities every year.
- 34 is the average age of death for those used in commercial sex;
 Homicide is the highest cause of death.
- 83% of sex trafficking victims in the U.S. are U.S. citizens.
