These kiosks are available 24/7 in branches and select Kroger stores across the state. Indiana BMV was also presented the International Winner for this award at the 2019 AAMVA Annual International Conference.

The second award, given in the category of Public Affairs and Consumer Education for print or electronic media publication, was for the BMV's <u>2017 Annual Report</u>. Published in January 2018, this is the first magazine-style annual report ever offered by the agency. It highlighted the BMV's activities and accomplishments and provided transparency to BMV's strategic goals and objectives.
