BMV Announces Danville Branch Closure

INDIANAPOLIS - Indiana Bureau of Motor Vehicles Commissioner Joe B. Hoage announced today he approved the proposal to close the Danville branch. The last day of operation for Danville is Saturday, Nov. 19, 2022

"The decision to close the Danville branch followed a multi-year transaction analysis as well as consideration of community feedback," said Commissioner Hoage. "These are difficult decisions for us to make, but with several branches located at a reasonable distance as well as more and more Hoosiers choosing to conduct transactions online and at kiosks, this closure enables us to more effectively use state resources while continuing to provide citizens with a variety of options."

Three additional branches are located within a 16-mile radius of Danville including Brownsburg, Plainfield, and Indy West. Both the Brownsburg and Plainfield branches have recently undergone renovation.

The Brownsburg branch was expanded to accommodate additional transaction volume and contains a BMV self-service kiosk providing 24-hour/7 day a week access to perform key BMV transactions. The Plainfield branch completed its multi-phase renovation earlier in 2022. The renovations included a larger lobby, eight additional customer service workstations, four additional testing stations, and a BMV self-service kiosk.
