

Indiana Entry Requirements: Poultry

All poultry entering Indiana must have:

A. *NPIP Participant Flocks: Official NPIP paperwork with annual testing*

OR

B. A certificate of veterinary inspection (CVI)
issued within 30 days prior to entry.

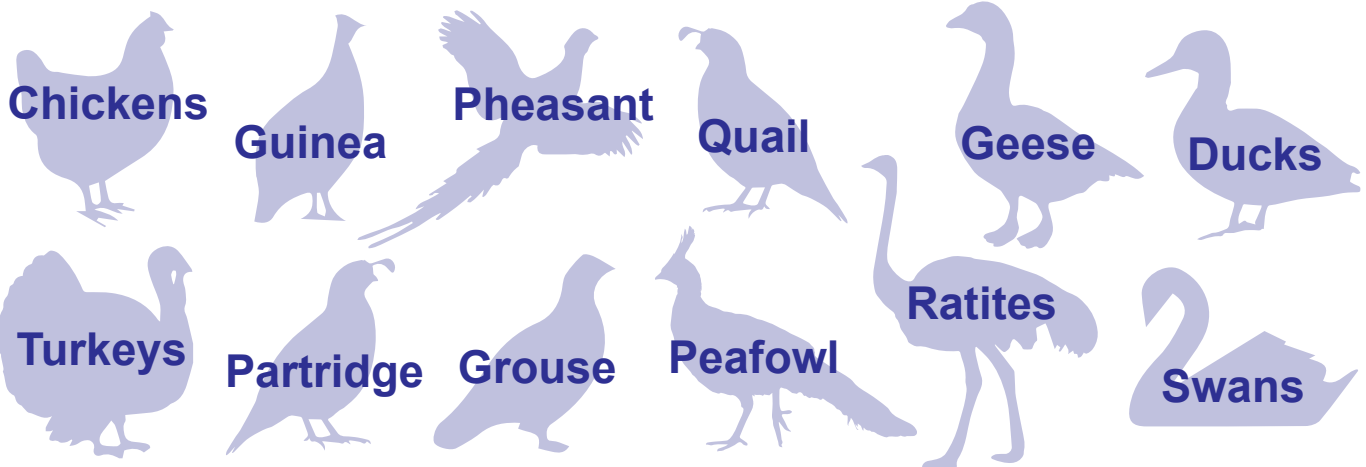

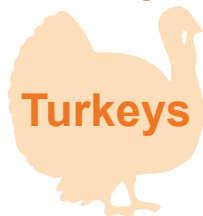
Meet the following testing requirements with a

Pullorum-Typhoid (PT) Stained-Antigen Rapid Whole Blood Test

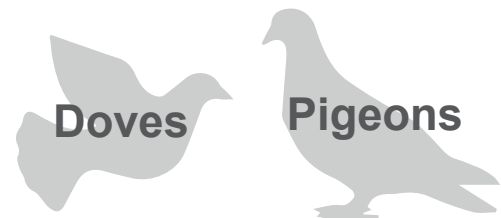


**Mycoplasma Gallisepticum (MG)
