

# COLLEGE GOING RATE (CGR)

- College Going Rate is the percent of students who enroll in a postsecondary institution within the year following high school graduation.
- 2022 HS Cohort CGR: 53%
  - Total number of high school graduates increased by 3% which means fewer total (headcount) of students enrolled in postsecondary directly after high school


#### **College Going Rate** (By HS Graduation Year)

- Overall CGR of 47% for CTE Concentrators and Completers
- Gaps by demographic exist similar to overall CGR





# 2022 COHORT COLLEGE GOING RATE


### SOCIOECONOMIC STATUS

#### ENROLLMENT BY INSTITUTION TYPE

27% of the high school class of 2022 enrolled at an Indiana public 4-year institution, followed by 10% who enrolled at an Indiana public 2-year institution.






## **2021 COHORT PERFORMANCE & PERSISTENCE**

- 51% of the 2021 HS cohort that enrolled in a postsecondary program met all three early college success benchmarks
- 77% of the 2021 cohort that enrolled in a postsecondary program persisted to the second year
  - Highest persistence rate in over 10 years

## **COMMISSION PRIORITIES** Support from the Frank O'Bannon grant (35% increase beginning with 2023 cohort)

- - Impact: Increase access, support persistence
- Continue Pre-Admissions letters (2025 cohort)
  - Impact: Increase knowledge of postsecondary options, removing barriers to access
- Continued expansion of the Indiana College Core offerings
  - Impact: Increase college preparedness, increase engagement with college-going experiences
- 21st Century Scholar auto enroll (2027+ cohorts) and Scholar Success Program Activities

- **OBPF Enrollment Metrics**
