## **Law Enforcement Training Grants Policy**

### **I. Purpose**

Pursuant to 2021 House Enrolled Act 1001 (“HEA 1001”), The Indiana Criminal Justice Institute (“ICJI”) is responsible for providing grants to city, town, and county law enforcement agencies to conduct law enforcement training, including the purchase of supplies and training materials. This policy aims to establish a consistent set of guidelines for city, town, and county law enforcement agencies to follow regarding the funds provided by ICJI.

### **II. Scope**

This policy applies to all city, town, and county law enforcement agencies that receive funds from ICJI pursuant to HEA 1001 and following the certification of fees collected under IC 35-47-2-3 in calendar year 2020.

### **III. Appropriate Funds**

Law enforcement agencies and/or the fiscal agents for such law enforcement agencies must deposit the funds received from ICJI into either 1) the fund they previously utilized for fees collected under IC 35-47-2-3, or 2) a fund specifically dedicated to law enforcement training costs.

### **IV. Allowable Costs**

Funds provided via law enforcement training grants may be utilized for any purpose allowable under IC 35-47-2-3(c) or any other purpose related to law enforcement training, including the purchase of supplies and training materials.

### **V. Issuance**

This policy is effective immediately. This policy will remain in effect unless and until canceled or rescinded by the Executive Director or their designee.
