Published Order Certifying Termination of Noncooperation  
Suspension

Pursuant to Indiana Admission and Discipline Rule 23(10.1)(c), this Court suspended Respondent from the practice of law in this State for failing to cooperate with the Indiana Supreme Court Disciplinary Commission concerning grievance **Nos. 23-0425 and 23-0618** filed against Respondent. On March 14, 2024, the Executive Director of the Disciplinary Commission filed a "Certification of Compliance," stating that Respondent has now cooperated with its investigation.

The Court therefore **ORDERS** that **Respondent's suspension from the practice of law for failure to cooperate in this case be shown as terminated as of March 14, 2024**, and that Respondent be shown as reinstated to the practice of law in this state if no other suspension is in effect.
