Order on Recommendations Made by Advisory Task Force on <u>Remote Access to and Privacy of Electronic Court Records</u>

On February 7, 2017, this Court issued Order No. 94S00-1702-MS-52, directing the implementation of certain recommendations made by the Court's Advisory Task Force on Remote Access to and Privacy of Electronic Court Records. Item No. 6 of that Order provides that attorneys who are registered with mycase.in.gov through the Roll of Attorneys may access all documents, except those which are sealed, in cases for which they are the attorney of record.

After further consideration and review of this directive with respect to the Mental Health (MH) and Adoption (AD) cases, the Task Force recommends that attorney of record access extend to those case types. The Court hereby orders the same.
