## **Meeting Minutes**

Meeting Called to Order by Nancy Lambring, Region 18 Manager

#### I. Welcome and Introduction of Council

Nancy Lambring welcomed everyone to the meeting and introduced the council members.

### II. Approval of Proposals for Region 18

Jason Nelson, Regional Services Coordinator explained the purpose of today's meeting was to vote on the selected proposals and noted that Region 18 only received 144 proposals. As a region the scoring team accepted every community based proposal that was submitted. He expects supplemental RFP's since there were gaps with some agencies not submitting proposals. Jason encouraged the service providers to keep a watch on the website for those potential RFP's. He also noted that the information on completing a RFP will be on the website, along with the schedule of the Regional Service Council meetings. Central office selected NYAP for Family Prep and Villages for Post-Adoption Services, which will also require a vote. For Community Partners Services in Region 18, Ireland Home Based services was selected. Jason acknowledged New Hope Services for being the community partner's provider for the past 13 years and thanked them for their service and work they have done in our community. Home of the Innocence was selected by the central office team for homebuilder services and does not require a vote.

Mark Barry made a motion to approve the selected proposals to move forward in the contracting process, seconded by Tawana Jackson all were in favor of the . Motion carried.
