Meeting Minutes

Meeting Called to Order by Nancy Lambring, Region 18 Manager

- I. Welcome, Introductions and Approval of Minutes Nancy Lambring welcomed everyone to the meeting and introduced the council members. Mark Barry made a motion, seconded by Brad Fortner to approve the minutes as read from the January 17, 2020 meeting. All were in favor, motion carried.
- **II. Budget Report** Kayla Bastin made a motion, seconded by Tawana Jackson to approve the minutes as read from the November 18, 2019 meeting. All were in favor, motion carried.
- **III. Programs and Services** Debbie Dailey reported that as a region we are at 75% of the budget. She reported that the oldest voucher to be processed is 28 days old. All of the finance team is able to work from home at this time.
- IV. Programs and Services Jason Nelson, Services Coordinator commended the service providers for the great work they have been doing in Region 18 during this health crisis. He informed those present that notifications went out for the agencies selected for the Family Preservation Services Contracts. He does not have the list to share today, but will send to Teri and to the council as soon as he is given the ok to do so.
- V. Community Partners Natalie Kassenbrock, Ireland Home Based Services informed those present that she emailed the reports out to the council last night. (see attached) They are making sure that their staff are following Director Stigdon's and central office's guidelines and seeing the children in their homes. They have seen an increase in housing referrals since this health crisis, typically 33% of the referrals that come in are for housing and that has jumped to 80%. She shared a couple of stories regarding families that they have most recently served. The target spending is 66% and they are at 63.3%.

- VI. Other Business Some of the service providers gave updates on their programs and how they are conducting business during this health crisis. Nancy Lambring discussed the potential need for housing of children of parents who are diagnosed and hospitalized with covid-19. There were a couple of facilities mentioned and plans are in the works, but nothing has been released as of yet. Those who are working with central office will reach out to Nancy once everything is in place.
- VII. Adjourn Judge Carmichael made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Amy Rutherford all were in favor meeting was adjourned at 10:53 a.m.

Ireland Home Based Services Community Partner for Child Safety April 1, 2020

As of April 1, 2020, a total of 139 referrals had been received since January 1, 2020. A home-based caseworker (HBCW) was assigned to 138 cases, a home-based therapist (HBT) was assigned to 1 case.

There are 90 levels currently being serviced through Community Partners for Child Safety to assist 90 families.

Region 18 received a total of 35 referrals during the month of January. Of these referrals, 9 cases came from Clark County, 17 from Floyd County, 0 from Harrison County, 1 from Scott County, and 8 from Washington County.

Region 18 received a total of 52 referrals during the month of February. Of these referrals, 13 cases came from Clark County, 19 from Floyd County, 3 from Harrison County, 6 from Scott County, and 4 from Washington County.



Recent Success Story:

This family was referred to Community Partners by a Resource Coordinator for Communities of School in Greater Clark County. This family consisted of mom, dad and two children. The family was facing eviction due to the father having surgery and losing his job. The mother also lost her temporary position due to trying to help care for the father due to his disabling condition from surgery. They had no family and only minimal friend supports in the area. They identified one friend who could care for the children in ensuring they had a consistent place to stay. IHBS assisted the family with finding resources for food and housing. We were able to get them on the list and get them a verification of homelessness letter from the Salvation Army. IHBS utilized funding through Community Partners to assist the family with paying for their storage unit so that they had somewhere to keep their belongings. The family was able to obtain an apartment and start new jobs which allowed them to sustain their monthly bills. Prior to closing this case, the children returned home with the family, the parents were following the budget that IHBS staff helped them create and were knowledgeable of the different resources they could utilize in their community.



Who is eligible for Community Partners?

The family cannot have an open case with the Department of Child Services. The children in the home cannot have an open case with Juvenile Probation.
