Meeting Minutes

Meeting Called to Order by John Kaiser, Region 18 Manager

I. Introductions/Approval of Minutes

II. Budget Report

Debbie Dailey, Regional Finance Manager was not present at today's meeting. John Kaiser informed those present that DCS has a budget reduction this fiscal year and that for the first three months Region 18 was about 3 ½ % over budget. Over all the State Budget is in good shape.

III. Community Partner's Report

Chelsea Engle filling in for Trish Kite-Hannon, presented the council with the CAPs report. The bulk of their referrals continues to come from Clark County and this past quarter they have seen an increase in referrals from Harrison County. All of the outcomes were met or exceeded with the exception of one, goal # 6. The top three referral sources were DCS, Schools and self and the top three services rendered were Public Aid Resourcing, Housing and Family Issues. Chelsea also announced that they are offering Car Seat Safety Checks on the 2nd Wednesday each month. Maribeth Adams-Wolfe from Our Place reported on their program, *Footprints for Life*. Donna Lloyd with Comfort House gave a report on their program, *Speak Up, Be Safe*.

IV. Programs and Services

Jason Nelson, Regional Services Coordinator announced that there will be a fall provider round table, hopefully it will be on November 20th at the Salem Government Center. He will notify services providers once he has confirmed the date and location.
