Residential Substance Use Treatment

Location: Residential Setting

Client: Parent/Caregiver (Services for youth would be provided through an ICPR)

Summary:

Residential treatment programs are characterized by offering 24 hour supervised living with a highly structured treatment program that includes individual, group, and family counseling. Residential treatment is comprehensive and intensive. The focus of residential treatment is to give the client the tools to begin a substance-free lifestyle and stabilize them in their recovery to help them be successful with outpatient treatment.

Residential treatment programs are paid at a per diem rate. The length of stay for residential services is 10-21 days. A referral to a residential treatment provider covers the cost of drug screens administered during services and does not require an additional referral.
