## NON-FINAL ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On August 8, 2017, Justin Guedel, on behalf of the Respondent, the Indiana Department of Homeland Security, submitted the attached request for dismissal of the above-captioned administrative appeal. The request states that the Respondent has issued an order of compliance for both Leo Tire locations (Saint Joseph, IN and Leo, IN), fully resolving this matter.

Accordingly, the Administrative Law Judge now enters this Non-Final Order of Dismissal. The ultimate authority in this matter is the Fire Prevention and Building Safety Commission. In the absence of an objection from a party or notice from the Commission of its intent to review any issue related to this order, the Commission shall affirm this order in accordance with Indiana Code § 4-21.5-3-29(c). This order will be considered by the Commission on September 7, 2017 at 9:00 a.m. (EDT), in Conference Center Room B, Indiana Government Center South, 302 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, IN 46204.
