LSA Document #21-461 Expedited Plan Review

PUBLIC HEARING RECORD

Overview

On Wednesday, December 15, 2021, at 9:00 a.m., Indianapolis (Eastern) time, the Fire Prevention and Building Safety Commission (the Commission) held a public hearing (the Public Hearing) on its proposed rule (LSA Document #21-461) to amend 675 IAC 12-3-2 to expand the scope of the expedited plan review process to cover all construction projects, regardless of occupancy classification. The Public Hearing was conducted in person in Conference Room 1 of the Indiana Government Center South Conference Center, 302 W Washington Street, Indianapolis, IN 46204. The Public Hearing was also conducted virtually, via Microsoft Teams video and teleconferencing. Members of the public were afforded the opportunity to access the meeting online or by telephone.

Hearing Record


