	<b>Division of Forestry Response</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• These strip mined spoils should be allowed more time for soil recovery and shading of briars, roses and raspberries before harvesting timber .</li> <li>• Concerned on harvest impact to lakes created by past strip mining and inconsistent BMP implementation.</li> <li>• Recommends reinventory of tract prior to the recommended 2020 harvest.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Plan recommendations are consistent with long term site recovery.</li> <li>• Harvest objective is to remove poor form and undesirable species to release crop trees expected to maintain good growth for the next 25 years and regenerate areas of poor quality growth. This is consistent with plan and comment concerns for long term forest recovery</li> <li>• BMP use will be monitored for performance.</li> <li>• The guide prescribes a timber harvest between 2020-2022. The tract will be re-assessed prior to the prescribed harvest.</li> </ul>
