The original guide was written in 2006. No regeneration openings were prescribed for this tract. Two were marked, a 4.8 acre opening at the north end and a 4.3 acre opening in a flat bottom area in the south-central portion of the tract. These areas were chosen based on the prevalence of poor growing stock. The majority of these trees were either damaged, defective, had poor form, or were undesirable species. An even-aged management approach on these productive sites should result in future stands with good stocking and quality stems.

The original guide incorrectly stated that there were no private property boundary lines adjacent to the tract. There is in fact private ownership adjacent to the tract. It is located at the southeast boundary and stretches approximately 800 feet. Trees along this line are marked with orange paint.

Pre-harvest grapevine control will be implemented in the openings using a 20% Garlon 4 basal bark application method.
