The original guide incorrectly stated that there were no private property boundary lines adjacent to the tract. There is in fact private ownership adjacent to the tract. It is located along the entire east boundary and stretches just over a ¼ mile. Trees along this line are marked with orange paint.

Two openings were marked in this tract. They are located in the northwest and northeast portions of the tract and are 1.5 acres and 5 acres, respectively. Pre-harvest grapevine control will be implemented in both openings, as well as bush honeysuckle control in the 5 acre opening. Control will be implemented using a 20% Garlon 4 basal bark application method.
