Executive Summary (AFL-CIO)

- The AFL-CIO Scale was presented for 948 projects, and was adopted 760 times (80.17% of total projects)
- The AFL-CIO Scale was presented in 383 hearings, and was adopted 329 times (81.84% of total hearings)


Executive Summary (ABC)

- The ABC Scale was presented in 73 hearings, and was adopted 52 times (12.94% of total hearings)


Executive Summary (DWD & "OTHER")

The Governor's Representative's vote directly affected the outcome of 10 hearings statewide during the survey period.

"Once-a-Month" Schedule Results (with comparison to 2007)

- Approximately 351 of 402 hearings (87.31%) were held in accordance with the "Once-a-Month" Schedule
- 1024 total hearings were held between January 1, 2007 and June 30, 2007
- For the first half of 2007, hearings were held on 160 separate days
- In 2008, this number decreased to 123 (23.13% reduction)

"Once-a-Month" Schedule Results (Continued)

- For the first half of 2007, Awarding Agencies scheduled 86 of 482 hearings themselves (17.84%)
- For the first half of 2008, Awarding Agencies scheduled 95 of 402 hearings (23.63%)

"Once-a-Month" Schedule Results (Continued)

- In the first half of 2007, the Governor's Representative attended 84.09% of the hearings scheduled by the Indiana Department of Labor
- For the first half of 2008, this number increased to 90.88%
- Overall attendance for 2007: 81.12%
- Overall attendance for 2008: 80.35%
