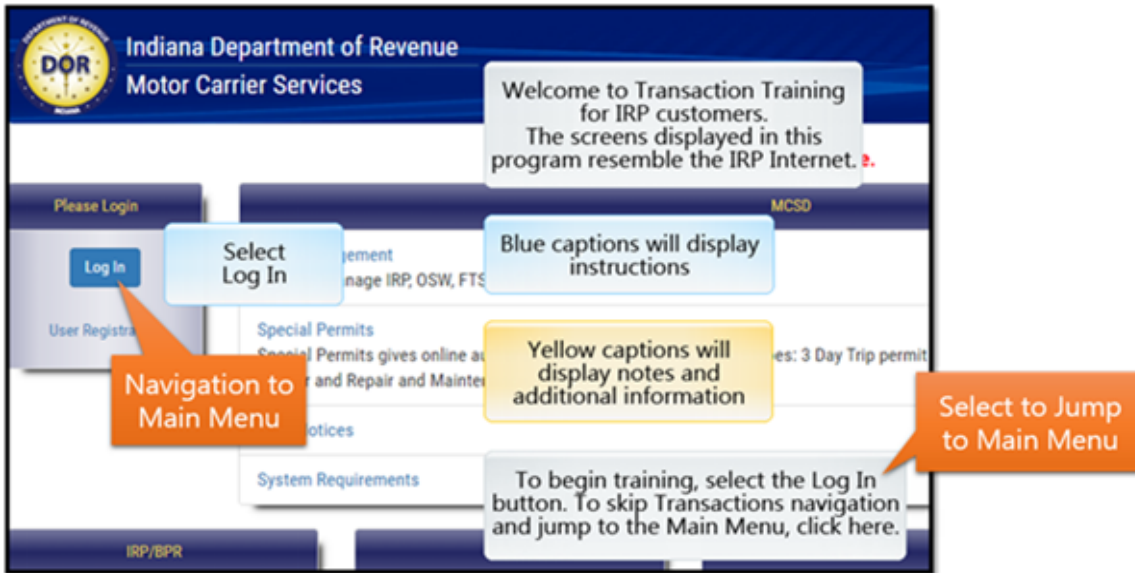
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Navigation

The training program for IRP Transactions is a simulation located via URL. Please see below for instructions regarding general navigation, notes, and prompts you will see in the material.

The image below is taken from the first slide you will see. There are three separate types of notes throughout the training slides: grey notes contain general navigation instructions, yellow notes contain additional notes and information regarding the content on the slide, and blue notes contain prompts to guide you through each process.



There will be a bar shown at the bottom of each slide. Please refrain from using this bar unless you are going back, rewinding, or selecting Play at the beginning of a transaction section. Do not use the fast forward button – follow the blue prompts to progress. The Play button is located at the beginning of each section in two places. Select either option to begin.

After playing each section, read all notes in the order they appear. You will be unable to progress until the blue prompt appears and gives instructions for the next step. Please note there is no audio in the training simulation.

Additional Notes

General

Transactions need to be billed and paid in sequential order.

Vehicles in a Manual Add Vehicle or Plate Transfer transaction will have the vehicle details pre-filled if they are already available in the MCS database.

Carrier Types

Small carriers have less than 100 vehicles, medium carriers have 100-300 vehicles, and large carriers have over 300 vehicles. The table below shows the manual and upload options for each carrier type.

User Type	Vehicle Count	Manual	Upload
Small Carrier	<100	Yes	No
Medium Carrier	100-300	Yes	Yes
Large Carrier	>300	No	Yes

Vehicle Search for Large Carriers

Large carriers will need to search for the specific vehicle(s) when completing transactions. They will not see a list of vehicles appear as it would with small and medium carriers. Vehicles can be found using the unit number, VIN, or plate number as shown in the image below.

Vehicle Search

- Select a search criteria, and enter a search value to retrieve a list of vehicles from the fleet.
- Once edit's are complete on vehicles from the search results, you can search for additional vehicles for edit.

Copy Transaction Feature

There is a feature that allows you to copy the transaction to the next registration period if your renewal is paid. The transaction will be automatically created in the next registration period. This is only available for manual transactions, not uploads.

You may see this appear in delete vehicle, add vehicle, plate transfer, replacement plate, and weight increase transactions if the transactions are eligible and if the transaction is manual, not an upload.

Uploads

Please note that each upload simulation purposely includes an error in the data that is populated during the first upload so that error correction can be demonstrated afterward.

Always use the template file available in the system and keep the same filename of the template that you download. The current file version is 4-0. To avoid errors, do not change the filename of the template you are uploading – simply save it and note the location where it is saved on your computer prior to uploading.

Skipped errors will not be a part of the transaction.

Billing

Billing options vary depending on carrier sizes.

You are eligible for live, immediate billing if you have less than 1,000 vehicles.

Carriers with 1,000-9,999 vehicles will receive a dashboard alert regarding batch billing, which takes 1-3 days. Carriers with 10,000+ vehicles will receive a dashboard alert when the bill is available online, which will occur over the weekend.
