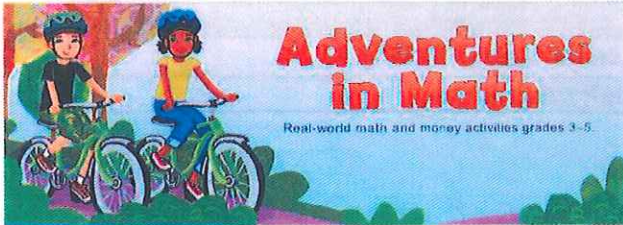




## Youth and Young Adult Education Curriculum Outline



### Adventures in Math

This Scholastic program promotes financial education and teaches third through fifth graders math and money skills. Modules include topics such as money basics, planning, goal setting, spending and saving.



### Teach Children to Save

Lessons are designed to meet educational standards in personal finance and reinforce concepts being taught in math, language arts and other disciplines. Lessons include teaching students where to safely store money, identifying coins, tracking money earned/spent, money flow, energy conservation and interest basics.
