Analysis of fiscal implications to overall budget as a result of raising rates	This activity has been completed and a fiscal analysis shows an approximate impact of \$1.2 million annually based upon the current population of children served.	As Indiana continues to have a waitlist for care increases rates does not allow us to serve as many children.
Working with the IT vendor to update the Automated Intake System (AIS) to include new rates	This activity has been added to the release schedule and will be completed prior to the September 30 2019.	No challenges noted at this time.
Create a communication strategy to ensure communities, programs and families understand the rate changes.	Communication plan has been completed and attached. Communications will begin in July via U.S. mail, CCR&R systems, social media platforms, email as well as posting on our OECOSL website.	No challenges noted at this time.
Implementation of new rates	Indiana remains on track to implement no later than September 30, 2019.	No challenges noted at this time.
