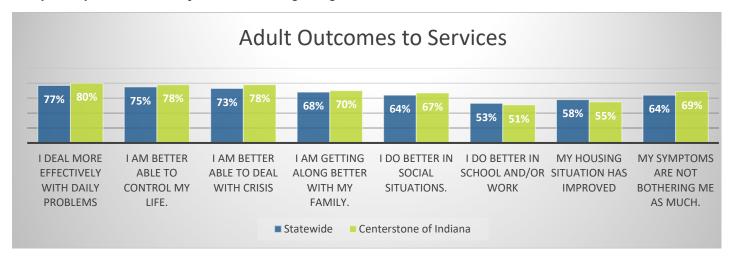

Why are the Division's numbers different from those provided by the community mental health center?

Community Mental Health Centers only submitted data to the Division for those individuals that meet the Division's income eligibility and diagnostic criteria.

Outcome Data

The Mental Health Statistics Improvement Program (MHSIP) survey is a nationally used survey and measures satisfaction of adults receiving services. This survey was handed out to all individuals receiving services during the period between August 30th and October 8th in 2020; 255 surveys were completed. Surveys were completed anonymously. Below are the questions asked regarding outcomes of services.



The Youth Services Survey for Families (YSS-F) is a nationally used survey and measures satisfaction of parents of youth receiving services. This survey was handed out to all individuals receiving services during the period between August 30th and October 8th in 2020; 206 surveys were completed. Surveys were completed anonymously. Below are the questions asked regarding outcomes of services.
