First Steps Logo

The primary First Steps logo is four-color and includes Indiana and family image and program name. This is to be used whenever possible (example: business cards, legal documents).

The logo must be surrounded by a designated amount of clear space on all sides, called the safe area. Below is a diagram

showing the safe area boundary for the logo. DO NOT crowd the logo's white space. No text can be placed within that area. Use the height and width of the f from the logo as a measurement to determine the minimum size of white space to allow on all sides.

Logo Guidelines

The primary, four-color First Steps logo is preferred for all use and to be utilized as much as possible. If the four-color logo cannot be used, then the two-color, one-color, black & white and reversed logos are recommended. The one-color logo may only be used in the defined primary color palette. You may use the reversed logo

on the navy blue from the color palette. Logo can also be reversed out on a photo, but is not recommended.

Regardless of whichever version you are using, please use it correctly (see incorrect usages below).

Color Guidelines

The primary color for First Steps is navy blue. The primary color is the dominant color in the palette. It's used to construct the logo and word mark and may also cover large surface areas. This color should be the first choice when selecting colors. Teal and yellow are secondary colors that should be used sparingly as accent

colors. Possible uses include design elements or colors for charts or graphs.

Always refer to these CMYK, RGB and Hex codes to ensure you are using the correct color.

Font Guidelines

The primary font for First Steps is the Objektiv Mk2 family. Objektiv Mk2 Regular and Objektiv Mk2 Italic should be used for general copy and long-form pieces. Objektiv Mk2 Bold, Objektiv Mk2 Bold Italic should be used for headlines and subheads as needed.

If the Objektiv font is not available, please use Arial in its place. Arial and Verdana are widely available across most operating systems.
