Approval of *EZflow*® by Infiltrator Geosynthetic Aggregate Technology; Indiana *EZflow*® *Elevated Sand Mound Design Manual*, April, 2019, for use of models 1201-P-GEO, 1201-A-GEO, 1021-P and 1201-A in residential and commercial Elevated Sand Mound on-site sewage systems.

The *Infiltrator EZflow® Indiana Elevated Sand Mound Design Manual*, April, 2019 is hereby approved by the Indiana State Department of Health (department), under the provisions of *410 IAC 6-8.3-52(h)*, *410 IAC 6-10.1-49(h)* and the *Indiana Standards for Infiltrator EZflow in Elevated Sand Mound Systems* published by the department on April 24, 2019; the current manual also bears this publication date.

This approval is for the use of the *Infiltrator EZflow®* in individual residential and commercial Elevated Sand Mound (ESM) onsite sewage systems. This approval is effective the 24th day of April, 2019 and expires and is subject to renewal by the department no later than the 31st day of March, 2020. This approval is subject to the conditions listed below:

- I. Infiltrator Water Technologies, LLC. is required to:
 - a) Certify distributors, designers, installers, service providers and those involved in the permitting and inspection process;
 - b) Submit to the department a list of all certified distributors, designers, installers, and service providers for the State of Indiana on a quarterly basis the first year and annually after that; and notify the department immediately of the removal of any certified distributor, designer, installer, or service providers;
 - c) Submit for review and approval of the department any proposed changes to any system component or the *Infiltrator EZflow® Indiana Elevated Sand Mound Design Manual* prior to implementation of the changes;
 - d) Notify the department of any scheduled training event at least 10 working days prior to the event;
 - e) Provide on-going consultation to health department staffs, designers, installers, and service providers;
 - f) Submit to the department on a annual basis the installation of any ESM onsite sewage system installed that includes an *Infiltrator EZflow®* using a data format provided by the department.



- II. The *Infiltrator EZflow*® ESM is subject to:
 - a) The applicable provisions of ISDH Rules 410 IAC 6-8.3 and 410 IAC 6-10.1;
 - b) Receiving and dispersing only domestic and residential strength wastewater;
 - c) The Infiltrator EZflow® Indiana Elevated Sand Mound Design Manual, April, 2019.
- III. The *Infiltrator EZflow*® distributor, designer, installer, service provider and those involved in the permitting and inspection process are subject to:
 - a) Infiltrator Water Technologies, LLC Certification;
 - b) Maintaining a status of good standing with Infiltrator Water Technologies, LLC.

This approval may be revoked or modified by the department for non-compliance, or if it is documented that it would not be in the best interests of public health for approvals to continue.

If you wish to request administrative review of this *Approval* pursuant to Indiana Code 4-21.5-3-5, you must file a petition for review within fifteen (15) days after this *Approval* is received.

The petition for review must be in writing and must include facts demonstrating that:

- The petitioner is a person to whom the *Approval* is specifically directed;
- The petitioner is aggrieved or adversely affected by the *Approval*; or
- The petitioner is entitled to review under any law.

If the petition for review is not filed timely, this *Approval* becomes FINAL. Any petition for review and petition for stay of effectiveness must be submitted in writing to:
