## Condition Name:

## Reporting Timeframe:

**Within One Working Day**

## TO REPORT:

- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in **NBS**
- Non-NBS users: Report with **this** form

## Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

- *Anaplasma phagocytophilum* in cell culture, immunohistochemical methods, IFA, PCR, NAAT or microscopic examination

## Condition Specific Reporting Details

- Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report and Treatment Information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report

## Additional Documentation to Include

- Applicable medical records (if available)
- Outpatient office visits
- Specialty consults
- Emergency department/hospital discharge summary
