Step 1: Call 317-233-7125

Step 2:

- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in **NBS**
- Non-NBS users: Report with **this** form

Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

- Isolation of *Clostridium Botulinum* from clinical specimen
- Detection of *botulinum* toxin in clinical specimen

Condition Specific Reporting Details

- Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report

Additional Documentation to Include

- Applicable lab results
- Applicable patient medical records
- CDC Botulism Case Report form
- Documentation of release of botulism antitoxin from CDC or [CDPH Infant Botulism Treatment and Prevention Program](#)
- Any noted exposure history, including travel
