- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in NBS
- Non-NBS users: Report with <u>this</u> form

Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

• Listeria monocytogenes detected by culture or culture-independent diagnostic testing (CIDT) from a clinical specimen

Condition Specific Reporting Details

• Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report

Additional Documentation to Include

- Applicable lab results
- Applicable patient medical records (if available)
- Include if pregnancy associated or in a newborn (< 28 days)
- Any noted exposure history, including travel and high risk food items
