#### **Condition Name:**

**Toxic shock syndrome** (streptococcal or staphylococcal)

#### **Condition Name in NBS:**

- Streptococcal toxic-shock syndrome
- Toxic-shock syndrome, staphylococcal

## **Reporting Timeframe:**

Within One Working Day

### TO REPORT:

- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in NBS
- Non-NBS users: Report with <u>this</u> form

### **Associated Reportable Laboratory Results**

• Streptococcus, group A (Streptococcus pyogenes) culture (streptococcal toxic shock syndrome only).

#### **Condition Specific Reporting Details**

• Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report.

#### **Additional Documentation to Include**

Relevant clinical documentation, if available.
