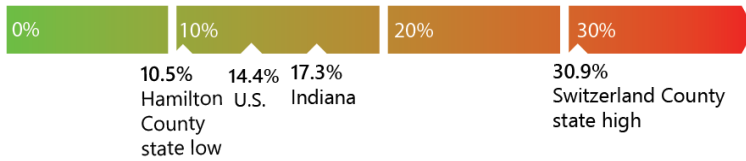

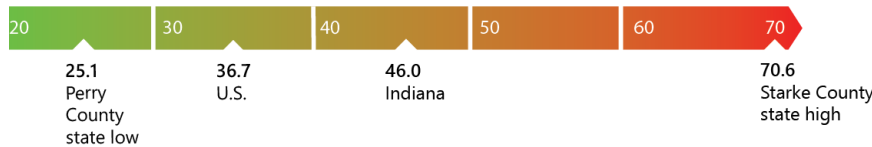

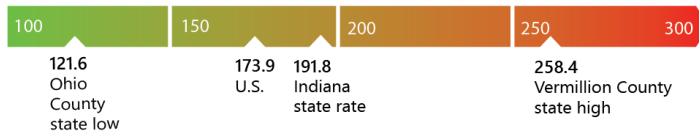
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **20.0%**



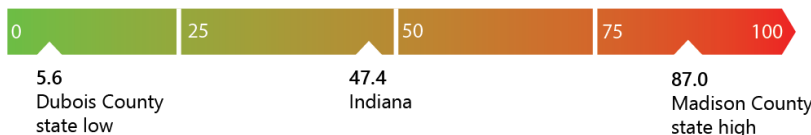
