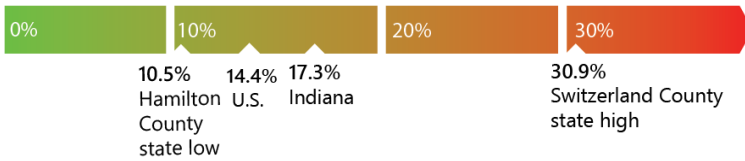

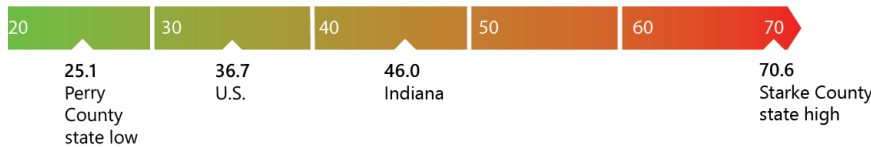

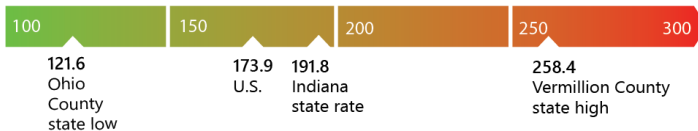
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **25.6%**



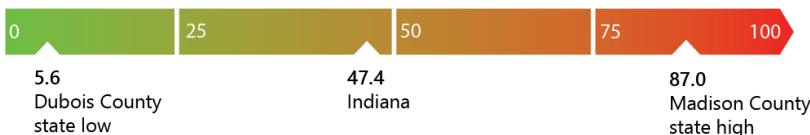
