PROPOSED FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW, AND ORDER

On December 19, 2006, Complainant, Dale L. Eggert II ("Eggert"), filed his Motion To Dismiss, a motion to which Respondent Smitty's Brake & Muffler Service ("SBMS"), has not responded.

Having carefully considered the foregoing and being duly advised in the premises the undersigned Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") for the Indiana Civil Rights Commission ("ICRC") proposes that the ICRC enter the following findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Eggert's complaint alleges that SBMS terminated his employment because of his association with in individual (his step-daughter) with a perceived disability (being HIV positive) in violation of the Indiana Civil Rights Law, IC 22-9. ("the ICRL"). COMPLAINT OF DISCRIMINATION (July 5, 2005) ("COMPLAINT").

- 2. SBMS disputed Eggert's claim of unlawful discrimination. NOTICE OF FINDING (August 9, 2006).
- 3. Eggert's Motion is expressly motivated by a settlement.
- 4. There is no evidence of fraud, coercion, duress, or any other reason not to approve the stipulated dismissal.
- 5. Any Conclusion Of Law that should have been deemed a Finding Of Fact is hereby adopted as such.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The ICRC has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties.
- 2. Settlement is a favored resolution and should be encouraged.
- 3. Administrative review of this proposed decision may be obtained by the filing of a writing specifying with reasonable particularity each basis for each objection within fifteen (15) days after service of this proposed decision. IC 4-21.5-3-29(d).
- 4. Any Finding Of Fact that should have been deemed a Conclusion Of Law is hereby adopted as such.

<u>ORDER</u>

- 1. Eggert's Motion To Dismiss is **GRANTED**.
- 2. Eggert's COMPLAINT is **DISMISSED**, with prejudice.
