For More Definite Statement Under Trial Rule 12(E)  
(EDra23020144)

Respondents, by counsel, have filed a Motion For More Definite Statement under Trial Rule 12(E) stating that the pleading of the Complainant is so vague and ambiguous that it does not provide

enough sufficient details for the Respondent to reasonably prepare a response. Indiana Trial Rule 12(E) allows for a party to “move for a more definite statement of a pleading to which a responsive pleading is allowed”, that the filed motion should be definitive enough to “clarify the theory and basis for the cause of action,” thus allowing another party to fully investigate, evaluate, and respond to them.

- ii. Sharika Fowler v. Metropolitan School District of Washington Township Motion For Judgment On The Pleadings (EMra23010071)

Respondent, by its counsel, files its motion due to Complainant failing to comply with the Claims Against Public Schools Act (“CAPSA”), Ind. Code Section 34-13-3.5, et. seq., before filing her Complaint, which means that her case must be dismissed on that basis as a matter of law.

The Administrative Law Judge in this matter DISMISSED, with prejudice, the Complaint of Discrimination under the IFHA against the Respondent, but did not move the Complaint Of Discrimination under the ICRL out of the administrative forum. **The objection period in this matter has closed.**
