Brief Description of Subject Matter: Procedures for the disposal of shredder fluff, a non-metallic by-product from the recovery of ferrous and non-ferrous metals from the use of industrial shredders.

This nonrule policy document is intended solely as guidance and does not have the effect of law or represent formal Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) decisions or final actions. This nonrule policy document shall be used in conjunction with applicable laws. It does not replace applicable laws, and if it conflicts with these laws, the laws shall control. A revision to this nonrule policy document may be put into effect by IDEM once the revised nonrule policy document is made available for public inspection and copying. IDEM will submit revisions to the Indiana Register for publication.

WASTE STATUS OF SHREDDER FLUFF

It has come to our attention that there are a number of facilities in Indiana engaged in efforts to recover ferrous and non-ferrous metals using industrial shredders. The non-metallic by-products of this activity, shredder fluff, is considered by this Office to be a special waste under the definition contained in 329 IAC 10-2-179 (a) (2). In addition to potential contamination by metals such as lead and cadmium, this type of fluff has also been shown to frequently contain low-levels of PCBs, which are regulated under 329 IAC 4. Please be advised that disposal of shredder fluff in any municipal solid waste landfill requires prior approval from this Office (329 IAC 10-8 and 329 IAC 4-10).


